Position: NEWPORT YOUTH PROJECT - Part-time Youth Ministry Worker (1 year post)

Organisation: Isle of Wight Youth for Christ

Context: Isle of Wight Youth for Christ, an Island-based Christian charity, is looking to recruit a part-time youth ministry worker for the Newport Youth Project.

The Newport Youth Project is a partnership between Isle of Wight Youth for Christ and Churches Working Together in Newport to help co-ordinate and increase youth ministry opportunities in the Newport area; creating more opportunities for young people to hear the good news (the gospel) of God's love revealed through Jesus and to see many more young lives changed by Jesus.

The role primarily involves:

This is a one year part-time post working for 9 hours per week during term time (39 weeks) and 40 hours for school holiday activities / events.

The appointed part-time worker will engage with young people (guide age range 9 to 20) from the Newport area. This worker will work under the guidance of the Newport Youth Project lead worker alongside oversight from the Project Steering Team and Isle of Wight Youth for Christ to expand and support the ongoing youth ministry in Newport as detailed in the job description.

Job Summary:

- **To help support inter-denominational youth ministry in Newport as outlined in the job description**
- **This role will include opportunities within schools, colleges and existing youth groups and outreach**
- **Working evenings and potential varying hours across the week**
- **40 extra hours for School holiday / weekend opportunities as arranged alongside lead worker**

There is an occupational requirement that the post holder is a committed Christian in accordance with Part 1 of Schedule 9 to the Equality Act 2010.
